The School of Journalism and Communication attaches great importance on education and maintains characteristics while learning from other top universities. The school serves local development needs and at the same time strengthens cooperation with foreign institutions. Focusing on "radio, television and new media", the school strives to localize, characterize and internationalize its disciplines. The school aims to be aligned with the trend of media convergence and mobile communication and serves local development and the development of Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area. Individual training programs and curriculum systems are provided for undergraduates and postgraduates. The school gives full play to the multi-disciplinary advantages of Guangzhou University and the location advantages of Guangzhou as a nationally central city. The school also maintains an active interaction with the local media and constantly innovates its talent training model.

General Description

The school was formally established in 2004 and is the earliest department in Guangdong Province to set up the undergraduate discipline of radio and television journalism, broadcasting and hosting art. There are two first-level disciplines which include journalism and communication as well as drama and film and television, and four undergraduate majors which include radio and television, broadcasting and hosting art, radio and television director and network and new media. The school consists of Journalism Department, Communication Department, Radio and Television Art Department, and Broadcasting and Hosting Art Department. There are 1,436 full-time undergraduates and 74 postgraduates.

The school has strong teaching and research strength. There are 54 full-time teachers which include 11 professors and 15 associate professors. The school has several teaching and research platforms to include a "2 + 2" news talent training mode innovation experimental area of Ministry of Education, a national first-class undergraduate discipline (radio and television director), a provincial first-class undergraduate discipline (radio and television), a provincial characteristic key discipline (radio and television) and Guangdong Province featured discipline (radio and television). The school enjoys excellent experimental teaching equipment. The total area of radio and television experimental teaching demonstration center is 1632.5

 \mathbb{m}^2 , which is awarded as the provincial experimental teaching demonstration center.

Over the years, the school has educated a number of professionals with integrity and professional skills for news agencies, government departments, program production and network communication companies. In recent years, through the large-scale recruitment of high-caliber talents and the development of high-level disciplines, the school is striving to build a leading and internationally influential modern school of journalism and communication.

This major aims to educate the students who can master the media system theory and broad scientific and cultural general knowledge based on radio and television, be familiar with news, publicity policies and regulations, fully understand the operation mode of radio and television industry, adapt to the development trend of radio, television and media industry, meet the needs of social communication, have good professional ethics and service spirit, have a high level of foreign language and become high-quality innovative talents with strong practical skills.

This major aims to educate high-caliber and inter-disciplinary talents who not only have the basic theoretical knowledge of communication and journalism but also have digital communication technology ability. The course is based on the integration of arts and sciences, so that students can be engaged in the production and management of information (especially the integrated reporting and new media marketing) in new media and various communication institutions when they graduate. Students will also be competent for the collection, analysis and presentation of network data of the Party and government organizations at all levels and other institutions and enterprises. (5) Zhang Xinzhi




Zhang Graduated in 2008 and received his PhD degree from the City University of Hong Kong. He is now an assistant professor at Hong Kong Baptist University.
